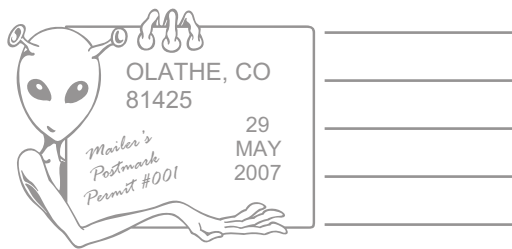
## **Day of Issue #1**

### **First Day of Use: April 12, 2007**

MPP design number 32 was added for the primary purpose of cancelling new USPS postage stamps. Olathe, CO then being an “un-official First Day of Sale (issue)” city. Remember that it was in 2007 that the USPS vowed to have all it’s new postage stamp issues available for sale at all post offices nationwide on their first day of issue dates.

We’ve also used this MPPcancel in conjunction with several of our own stamp releases, too.

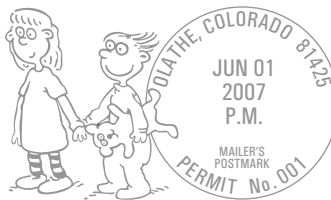


**Space Alien**

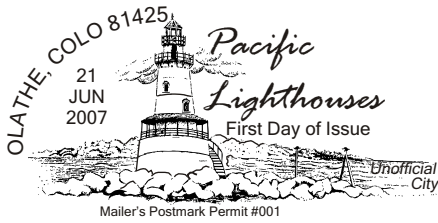
