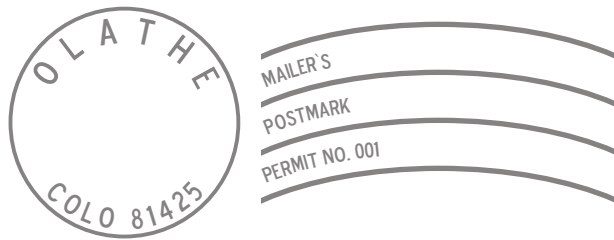


## **Double-Wing (Heavy) Killer Bars ~ Self-Inking** First Day of Use: March 02, 2010
